1.1. Improves maintenance tool stability


The error, which interrupted downloading (i.e. restoring data) and showed the message of "LogicEditor: Consistency Error", has been fixed.

2. Updating Procedure

Use the following procedure to update the Network Configurator to Ver. 3.34. To update the Network Configurator to Ver. 3.3* must have been installed. Updating from Ver. 1* and Ver. 2* is not supported.

2.1. Updating

 Execute the update module (NetworkConfigurator_for_DeviceNet_Safety_v3.34.0308_Update_Us.exe).

- 2. Follow the instructions displayed on the wizard to update the version.
- 3. When the following screen is displayed, updating is completed.



2.2. Confirmation of Installation

Windows XP

Select *Control Panel - Add or Remove Programs* from the Windows Start Menu.

Next, select the *Network Configurator for DeviceNet Safety v3* from the installed program list, and then refer to the support information.

If 3.34.0308 is displayed for the version in the Support Info Dialog Box, the software has been updated correctly.

■ Windows Vista

Select *Control Panel - Programs - Program and Features* from the Windows Start Menu. Next, select *Network Configurator for DeviceNet Safety v3* from the list of installed programs. If the Details Pane is not displayed on the Program and Features Window, select *Organize - Layout - Details Pane* in this order.

If *V3.34.0308* is displayed for the product version in the Details Pane, the software has been updated correctly.

■ Windows 7

Select *Control Panel - Programs - Program and Features* from the Windows Start Menu. Next, select *Network Configurator for DeviceNet Safety v3* from the list of installed programs. Like Windows Vista, if *V3.34.0308* is displayed for the product version in the Details Pane, the software has been updated correctly.
